ROGER WILLIAMS has been spoken of as "an epoch-making character", and as a great scholar. While attending the University of Cambridge, he mastered not only Latin, Greek and Hebrew, but also the French and Dutch languages. He was patriot, religious reformer, and disciple of liberty. He left Massachusetts to seek religious freedom and found Rhode Island which was open to anyone seeking toleration of religious opinion. He dedicated it to the shelter of "persons distressed for conscience". He was an individualist with tolerance for all. He yielded in conformity to none. He was Netop (friend) to the Indians, but was anathema to stiff-necked Puritans.
